

Supported Employment Specialist

The Supported Employment Specialist will provide on-going follow along support services in order to assist individuals with disabilities/mental health and/or substance abuse in maintaining community-based employment.

- Develop an individual service plan which will implement yearly goals to identify services needed.
- Provides re-training and job placement services when necessary to clients on caseload.
- Coordinates all services related to maintaining the clients employment such as mental health services, food stamps, social security benefits, etc.
- Transport clients utilizing own personal vehicle during course and scope of job duties.
- Applicants must qualify for Level II background screen
- Prefer Bachelor's degree in social work, rehabilitation, counseling or other human services field.
- One year experience in providing supported employment or employability development to persons with disabilities.
- Complete all paperwork that is required by funding sources.
- Additional work and life experience may be substituted in place of the experience stated qualifications.
- Valid driver license, registration and vehicle insurance required.
